

Anesthesia and Sedation Updates for Dentistry and Oral Maxillofacial Surgery May 6-8, 2021



COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A review of sedation and anesthesia utilizing didactic teaching and hands-on simulations to convey concepts and practice skills, develop a team approach and enhance patient safety. The first day is a full eight hours of virtual didactics covering topics of importance to dentists using sedation and oral and maxillofacial surgeons administering GA. Day two consists of morning lectures and afternoon simulations for clinicians who treat children.

Saturday is devoted to hands-on sessions that are designed to complement the lecture material by enhancing skills and reinforcing

appropriate protocols for airway management and the recognition and treatment of anesthesia related emergencies.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this program, participants will be able to:

1. Recognize common and uncommon complications in office anesthesia
2. List appropriate sedation agents for a range of clinical scenarios
3. Discuss key pharmacologic considerations related to the agents used during moderate sedation and office-based general anesthesia
4. Identify elements of the history and physical that suggest a difficult airway
5. Develop a sedation checklist that includes the critical elements including medication management, PONV risk assessment, BMI considerations and fire safety.

STRUCTURE

The purpose of the program is to review key concepts in anesthesia and sedation, introduce new issues for the sedation dentist and the oral and maxillofacial surgeon, and to enhance emergency preparedness focusing on team management.

Day 1: Lecture presentations from 7:45 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on core anesthesia topics and issues of significance to participants.

This day will be all virtual with no limit on participant number.

Day 2: Hybrid lecture presentations from 7:45 a.m. – Noon on anesthesia topics of interest to clinicians treating children. Simulations will be conducted in the afternoon. In-person participation will be limited.

Day 3: Simulations from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Participant number will be limited.
